# Raya gift for Tiara Sendayan community

## Developer contributes RM200,000 towards building fund for surau

THE Muslim community in Taman Tiara Sendayan near Seremban received a perfect gift for Hari Raya Aidilfitri when Matrix Concepts Holdings donated RM200,000 to a fund set up for the construction of a *surau* in the residential area.

Matrix Concepts group managing director Ho Kong Soon expressed hope that the contribution would help realise the *surau* pro-tem committee's aim to build a place of worship.

"This contribution is part of our corporate vision to build communities and provide a conducive living environment for them to prosper in.

"We will continue to assist residents in our developments to build places of worship so they can lead more meaningful lives," he said at a cheque presentation ceremony at the office of Negri Sembilan Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Aminuddin Harun.

Ho said this was also in line with the government's policy to build communities with a strong religious foundation.

He said Matrix decided to assist in the construction of a *surau* on a reserved plot in Tiara Sendayan as there was a pressing need for a place of worship in the residential area that was undergoing rapid development.

"We also built the Tiara Biz food court, comprising 12 shop-lots, and handed it over to Seremban City Council late last year.

"This is the company's aim to produce more entrepreneurs while being a catalyst to further develop the local economy," he said, adding that the project

was also part of the group's corporate social responsibility initiative.

Aminuddin, in his speech, thanked Matrix Concepts for the donation.

"More companies should emulate Matrix Concepts and help the government to provide facilities for the people through their CSR work.

"It is my hope that the residents will make full use of the facilities at the *surau* and carry out activities, including community work, for common benefit," he added.
